I have spent the last two months working as a live in nanny in London; unfortunately the family had a change in employment status, which meant they could not afford to keep me on. Last year I completed 4 months working as an Au Pair in Paris, which combined two interests of mine, looking after children and the ability to travel.

During my time with this family I was responsible for the care of a girl aged 8 and a boy aged 6. This was a sole charge role and it was my responsibility to get the children up and ready for school as well as driving them to school and ensuring they were there on time. During the day I tidied the house and organised washing as well as preparing a healthy home cooked meal for dinner. I would then collect the children from school and ensure that they completed their homework, music practice and also made sure they were fed and bathed ready for bed. One of the values I have taken from this experience was my ability to adapt to different cultures and religious beliefs as the family were Jewish and followed a strict Kosher diet.

Au Pair

Paris, France

September–December 2015

During my time with this family, I was looking after a boy aged 13 and a girl aged 10. I was primarily in sole charge of both children, although I did spend most of my time with the 10 y/o (as you can imagine). Daily duties included; cooking good nutritious meals at lunchtime (as they both came back for lunch from school: their school being 5 minutes walk from the household), along with preparing the family meal in the evenings. Cleaning up and washing dishes, helping with homework if required, general housework including washing and ironing, food shopping and just generally spending time with both children (either together or one to one) by engaging them in different activities e.g. table tennis, arts and crafts, Piano, Guitar, game play or cooking/baking etc.

As a photographer I get to work with children ranging from newborn up until early teenage years. Duties include guiding each child and making them feel comfortable by developing a rapport with them to produce the most natural images of the children, whilst also working with the parents in the most friendly, natural and fun way. Nursery Assistant (work placement)

Working in a nursery environment requires full attention and co-ordination at all times. Duties included; assisting children with eating at meal times, providing correct discipline when needed, taking the younger children out for a walk in the park and using appropriate clothing, soothing the younger children during scheduled nap times and last but defiantly not least: keeping the children engaged in play and encouragement in trying new activities and socialising with other children. During my time here I was working mainly with ages 2 - 5.

Fulltime Live-Out Nanny/Mothers Help

In this role I am in sole charge of a newborn and a 3 y/o. Duties include getting the children a healthy breakfast and bottle sterilisation. Bathing and taking the oldest to nursery locally, organising play dates/activities/going for walks around the countryside. Preparation of healthy lunches, tidying up, staying on top of general house chores and running errands while the mother is at work (around 1-1.5 days a week). Whilst keeping correct time management.

Au Pair

Melbourne, Australia

January–June 2011

Throughout my time working with this family I was looking after 3 children; aged 7 weeks, 2 and 6. I would get up just before the children and would prepare a healthy breakfast (and lunch for the oldest to take to school). I would get them both settled and dressed, both cleaned and ready for the day. I would walk them both to the school, then I would take the 2 y/o to the park or organising play dates/activities/groups. Duties also included toilet training, cleaning and feeding. I would be in charge of baby appropriate activities such as stimulation, bottle preparation and sterilisation, baby changing and sleeping patterns whenever needed (mother worked from home). When the school day was over, I would pick up the older one from school and cook healthy meals, help her with any homework she might have (while entertaining the little ones too), then last of all, bathing, brushing of teeth and ready/settled for bed.
